SUBJECT: Allocation of Development Impact Fee Funds

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board:

- 1) Authorize the use of up to \$47,568.80 of Development Impact Fees from the San Gorgonio Pass Area Flood Control Facility Fund (Fund 30541) for costs associated with Noble Creek Channel.
- 2) Direct the Executive Office to transfer up to \$47,568.80 of Development Impact Fees from the San Gorgonio Pass Area Flood Control Facility Fund (Fund 30541) to the Flood Control and Water Conservation District as needed, pursuant to contracts and billings received for the Noble Creek Channel.

BACKGROUND:

The Development Impact Fee (DIF) program, which is governed under Ordinance 659.6, allows for the use of DIF funds for those facilities identified on the Public Facilities Needs List to the Year 2010, in which the Noble Creek Channel is included.
