**SUBJECT: Amendment #1 to PSSF Agreement #CP3016-06
Parents Anonymous**

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BACKGROUND:

On January 1, 2004, AB636, the California Outcomes and Accountability Act, became effective and mandated that all counties conduct a comprehensive assessment of child welfare services. In response to AB636, Riverside County DPSS and Riverside County Probation Department initiated a community and self-assessment to cover the period from July 2005 to June 2008. The Self-Assessment and Improvement Plan was completed and released to the public in June 2004.

As a result of its review of the Plan, the Prevent Child Abuse Riverside County (PCARC) planning body recommended that CAPIT/PSSF funds be utilized to support program evaluation services. On February 1, 2006 several Requests for Proposals were released. Through the RFP and competitive bid process, Parents Anonymous was recommended to serve as program evaluator for the CAPIT and PSSF Programs. On May 16, 2006, your Honorable Board approved this recommendation within the FY06/07 CAPIT and PSSF Funding Recommendations (Agenda #3.20)

Parents Anonymous, in support of the CAPIT/PSSF services provided by vendors under contract with DPSS, gathers statistical data from vendors and clients participating in CAPIT/PSSF services. These data are compiled into monthly and annual reports to DPSS. The reports include information on client demographics, vendor service production, and client outcomes.

Pursuant to AB636, a County Needs Assessment must be conducted every three years. Riverside County DPSS is, therefore, initiating a needs assessment to cover the period, July 2008 to June 2011. The Needs Assessment process requires the input and participation of the community over a period of time. As Program Evaluator, Parents Anonymous will facilitate the assessment process, assist in the analysis and write the final report.

Consequently, DPSS is seeking the Board's approval to allocate an additional \$15,000 of Family to Family funds to support the assistance of Parents Anonymous for the required Community Needs Assessment.
