SUBJECT: Reconstruction of Four Segments of Rancho California Road, Sycamore Mesa Road to the Temecula City Limit, Temecula area

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approve the plans and specifications for the reconstruction of four segments of Rancho California Road, between Sycamore Mesa Road and the Temecula City Limit in the Temecula area of Riverside County. Authorize the Clerk to advertise for bids to be received in the office of the Director of Transportation up to the hour of 2:00 pm, Wednesday, June 27, 2007, at which time bids will be opened.

BACKGROUND: The pavement on Rancho California Road between Sycamore Mesa Road and Temecula City limits has become deteriorated and is in need of improvement. A Federally funded project was awarded on January 23, 2007 (agenda item 3.45) to repair storm damaged portions of Rancho California Road, including some areas between Sycamore Mesa Road and Temecula City limits.

This project is to improve the remaining four segments of Rancho California Road between Sycamore Mesa Road and Temecula City limits not included in the storm damage project, because the Federal Highway Administration determined that these repairs are not eligible for Federal storm damage reimbursement. The Transportation Department recommends these additional pavement repairs to improve the pavement conditions on Rancho California Road for motorists.
