**SUBJECT:** Ordinance No. 847.1 Amending Section 8. of Ordinance No. 847  
Regulating Noise

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:

Introduce and on the following week adopt Riverside County Ordinance No. 847.1 amending Section 8. of Ordinance No. 847 regulating noise.

**BACKGROUND:** The existing Riverside County Ordinance No. 847 regulating noise permits the Sheriff to enforce noise violations. After some discussions with the Sheriff and other interested parties it was determined that the Code Enforcement Department could be an effective additional noise enforcement authority.

The attached Ordinance accomplishes the addition of Code Enforcement as an enforcement authority for noise violations. No additional staff is requested and it is anticipated that this activity will be supported from the current budget.

Revenue is unknown until some experience is gained with enforcement. Administrative Citation revenue will offset some general fund costs.

3 AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
4 OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AMENDING  
5 ORDINANCE NO. 847 REGULATING NOISE

7 The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside ordains as follows:

8 Section 1. Section 8. of Ordinance No. 847 is amended in its entirety to read as  
9 follows:

10 Section 8. ENFORCEMENT. The Riverside County Sheriff and  
11 Code Enforcement shall have the primary responsibility for enforcing this ordinance;  
12 provided, however, the Sheriff and Code Enforcement may be assisted by the Public  
13 Health Department. Violations shall be prosecuted as described in Section 10. of this  
14 ordinance, but nothing in this ordinance shall prevent the Sheriff, Code Enforcement or the  
15 Department of Public Health from engaging in efforts to obtain voluntary compliance by  
16 means of warnings, notices, or educational programs.”

17 Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after its adoption.
