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BACKGROUND: Pursuant to the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 and Resolution 2007-150 adopted April 17, 2007, the Board of Supervisors noticed a public hearing for June 12, 2007, to receive testimony regarding the annexation of Location 5 to Zone 41 of Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated (L&LMD No. 89-1-C). Annexation of Location 5 to Zone 41 will fund the maintenance and servicing of fossil filters within public rights-of-way located northerly and southerly of Prairie Smoke Rd and 68th St; southerly of Goose St, Logsdon Dr, 65th St; northerly of Schleisman Rd ; easterly and westerly of Oosten Farms Rd, Fiske Dr, and Whitewell Rd; westerly of Archibald Ave and Cleveland Ave; and easterly of Sumner Ave in the Eastvale area and includes 947 single-family residential lots.

On April 18, 2007 a notice of the public hearing and mail-in ballot, an impartial analysis, a copy of Resolution No. 2007-150, and an information sheet was mailed to all property owners within Location 5, proposed for annexation to L&LMD No. 89-1-C. Pursuant to the notice, all ballots must be returned prior to the conclusion of the public hearing.

Notice of the public hearing was also given by publication of a certified copy of Resolution No. 2007-150 in The Press Enterprise at least ten (10) days prior to the public hearing date and by posting a certified copy of the Resolution No. 2007-150 on the official bulletin board customarily used by the Board of Supervisors for the posting of notices and in two other public locations within the County.

Section 53753 of the Government Code has been amended. It requires that the Board after conducting the public hearing designate an impartial person, having no vested interest in the outcome of the proposed annexation, to tally the ballots received by the close of the public hearing at a specified time, date and place.
