BACKGROUND:

Exhibit A to Franchise Area 8 was originally promulgated in June of 1997, with an amendment occurring in August of the same year. Since that time, various factors have changed that require an update to the Exhibit.

This amendment replaces Exhibits A and A.1 to make the exhibit current with operations at the Idyllwild, Anza and Pinyon Flats Collection Centers.

The changes in Exhibit A. include:

- Adding the Residential Winter Use Card for Poppet Flats and Twin Pines Residents
- Adding Bulky Waste Collection at the Anza Collection Center
- Adding Pine Needle and Slash Collection at the Anza Collection Center
- Revise the Gate Hours at the Pinyon Flats Collection Center to reflect actual hours open
- Adding Recycling Services at the Pinyon Flats and Anza Collection Centers
- Add Commercial Slash and Green Waste at the Anza Collection Center
- Deleting the Pod System Vehicles and adding Roll- off Trucks and Trailers as types of collection equipment
- Change the "Community Drop Off Center language" to allow for future locations

Staff has reviewed the proposed amendment and has determined it to be consistent with the purpose and intent of the exclusive franchise agreement.

FINANCIAL:

This amendment to the franchise will have no fiscal impact to the County. Franchise fees paid to the County are based upon revenue from the company's commercial collection activities only. The Franchisee pays no fees to the County from residential parcel charges.
