SUBJECT: Purchase Of Surgical Implants Without Securing Competitive Bids For Riverside County Regional Medical Center.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Authorize the County Purchasing Agent to approve the purchase of surgical implants from SeaSpine, Inc., without seeking competition, pursuant to Ordinance No. 459.4.
2. Authorize the County Purchasing Agent to exercise the option to renew annually for up to four (4) years in one-year increments, providing the unit price increase does not exceed the Consumer Price Index.

BACKGROUND: On February 24, 2004, agenda item 3.30 the Board of Supervisors approved the purchase of surgical instruments, supplies and implants from various vendors to allow the hospital an opportunity to compile a purchase history, evaluate, and verify the need to continue these proprietary contracts. On July 11, 2006, agenda item 3.52 the Board of Supervisors approved a list of new and previously approved vendors as sole source and proprietary purchases. SeaSpine, Inc. was inadvertently omitted from the list for approval.
