SUBJECT: Seventh Amendment to Household Hazardous Waste Collection Services Agreement with Clean Harbors, El Dorado, LLC (formerly Teris LLC (dba) MSE Environmental)

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve the Seventh Amendment to the Household Hazardous Waste Collection Services Agreement with Clean Harbors, El Dorado, LLC to extend the Agreement term for six months from July 1, 2007 to December 31, 2007 in the amount of \$750,000 and;
2. Authorize the Chairman to execute Amendment on behalf of the County.

BACKGROUND: On March 21, 2006, the Board of Supervisors approved the transfer of the Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Program from the Environmental Health Department (EHD) to the Waste Management Department (WMD) effective July 1, 2006. Since the transfer, WMD has successfully transitioned the Program's city contracts, permits, collection facilities, educational programs, budget, and equipment and hired staff to oversee almost 200 open days of HHW service available to the County's residents.

BACKGROUND: *(continued)*

On August 18, 2006, Teris, LLC (dba) MSE Environmental (Former Contractor), as part of a sale of membership, became Clean Harbors, El Dorado, LLC (Contractor) and acquired all the interests of the Former Contractor and changed its name to Clean Harbors, El Dorado, LLC. All responsibilities and obligations under Agreement of Former Contractor were assigned to the Contractor and the established amount of compensation for Fiscal Year 2006/2007 for all expenses would not exceed \$1,500,000. The period of performance for this service was five years.

WMD is seeking approval to extend this agreement for (6) six months as requested in order to avoid interrupting the HHW Collection Program and service to Riverside County residents, while the WMD completes a competitive bid process and negotiates a new agreement with a qualified, licensed firm for HHW Collection Services.

PRICE REASONABLENESS

The current contractor, Clean Harbors, El Dorado, LLC is willing to extend this agreement with the WMD for (6) six additional months without changing any contractual terms, except those that address the period of performance, the additional (6) six months of compensation, and the update list of scheduled HHW collection events.
