SUBJECT: Edom Hill Transfer Station - Amendment No. 2 to the Agreement for Disposal of Solid Waste

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board:

- 1) Approve Amendment No. 2 to the Agreement for Disposal of Solid Waste with Burrtec Recovery and Transfer, LLC, regarding Designated Disposal Sites for the acceptance of solid waste residue from the Edom Hill Transfer Station.
- 2) Authorize the Chairman to execute the Amendment on behalf of the Board.


BACKGROUND: The Agreement for Disposal of Solid Waste currently allows Burrtec Recovery and Transfer, LLC to deliver solid waste from the Edom Hill Transfer Station to the El Sobrante Landfill on a daily basis. The shipments are not to exceed more than 20 percent of the average daily tonnage of the transfer station (and no more than 400 tons per day from the transfer station facility). These shipments to El Sobrante are supposed to arrive at the landfill between the hours of 8:00 PM and 12:00 AM in order to relieve any potential burden on the peak traffic hours.

The Department contends that the waste delivered to El Sobrante from the Coachella Valley by way of the Edom Hill Transfer Station should be disposed at the Lamb Canyon Landfill or the Badlands Landfill, thereby lessening the air quality and transportation impacts Riverside County experiences with current practice. This Amendment eliminates the existing provisions regarding deliveries to the
