SUBJECT: Quail Valley Municipal Advisory Council

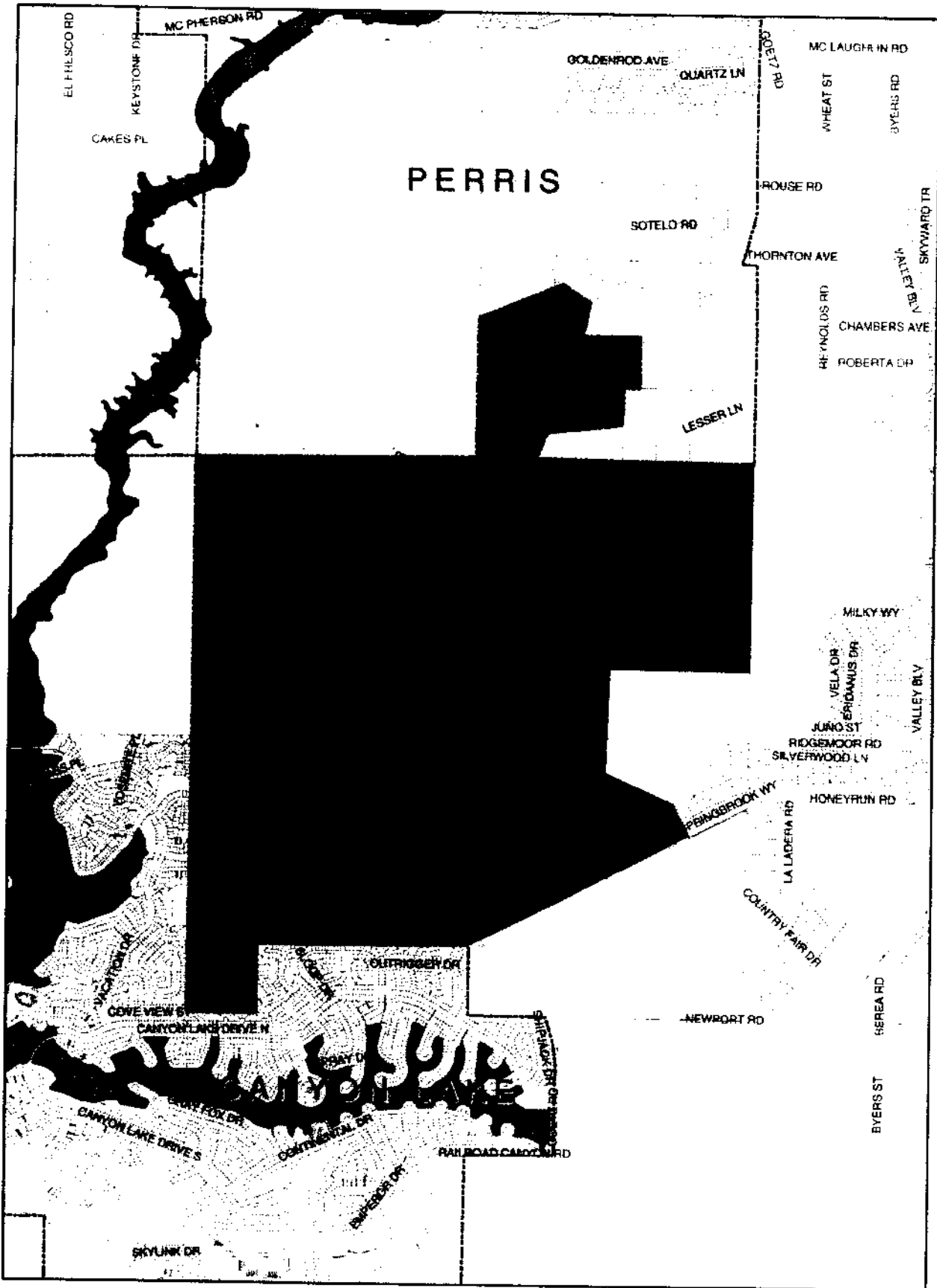
RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board join with me in adopting Resolution No. 2007-269 creating the Quail Valley Municipal Advisory Council.

5 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE
6 CREATING THE QUAIL VALLEY MUNICIPAL ADVISORY COUNCIL

8 WHEREAS, Government Code §31010 and Riverside County Board of Supervisors Policy
9 No. A-51 provide for the creation of a Municipal Advisory Council within unincorporated territory for the
10 purpose of advising the Board of Supervisors on matters including, but not limited to, public health, safety,
11 welfare, public works and planning; and

12 WHEREAS, creation of a Municipal Advisory Council has been requested by constituents within
13 the Quail Valley area; now therefore,
14

15 BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State
16 of California, in regular session assembled on July 3, 2007, that the Quail Valley Municipal
17 Advisory Council is hereby created.
18

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the operation of the Quail Valley Municipal
20 Advisory Council (hereinafter referred to as the "**Quail Valley MAC**") shall be in compliance with the
21 rules, regulations and procedures prescribed in Riverside County Board of Supervisors Policy No. A-51,
22 and with the specific provisions delineated below in this Resolution.

24 1. TERRITORY. The territory for which the Quail Valley MAC is established, and area over
25 which it extends, is situated within the Third Supervisorial District and defined, more or less, as the Quail
26 Valley area of Riverside County, all as more specifically shown and depicted on Attachment A to this
27 Resolution.

1 2. MEMBERSHIP. The Quail Valley MAC shall consist of five (5) regular members and one
2 (1) alternate member, each of whom shall be appointed by the Board of Supervisors and serve at the
3 pleasure of the Third District Supervisor. All appointees shall be at least eighteen (18) years of age. Any
4 member who misses two (2) consecutive MAC meetings is terminated from membership on the MAC.
5

6 3. TERM. Appointed members shall serve without compensation for a term of (2) years,
7 except that in order to establish a system of staggered terms, three (3) of the initial members shall be
8 appointed to serve a term of one (1) year. The other two initial members shall be appointed to serve a term
9 of two (2) years. Thereafter, all terms shall be for two (2) full years.
10

11 4. BOARD POLICY NO. A-51. The provisions of Riverside County Board of Supervisors
12 Policy No. A-51 on the subject of "Formation / Operation of Municipal Advisory Councils and Community
13 Councils" are incorporated herein to this Resolution by reference, and are intended for the guidance of the
14 Quail Valley MAC in carrying out its duties.
