

**SUBJECT:** Waiver of Disposal Fees for Southern Coachella Valley Community Services District's Illegal Dumping Program

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board authorize the Waste Management Department to waive disposal fees in order to support the Southern Coachella Valley Community Services District's illegal dumping prevention efforts.

**BACKGROUND:** The Southern Coachella Valley Community Services District (CSD) is located in the southern portion of eastern Riverside County within the 4th Supervisorial District. This area, due to its remote, rural nature, and the part-time operation of local landfill facilities is highly susceptible to illegal dumping. The CSD has historically aggressively combated illegal dumpers by working closely with the Sheriff's Office, Code Enforcement and the Waste Management Department to discourage illegal dumping, enforce mandatory collection among its residents and organize successful community cleanups. In addition, the CSD augments the ongoing illegal dumping retrieval efforts by TLMA (per the Code Enforcement Illegal Dumping Program) and the Waste Management Department's Illegal Dumping Cleanup Program by retrieving illegally dumped material and taking the waste to a centralized location within the CSD, also known as the TOM (Thermal, Oasis, Mecca) site. Also, the CSD allows its residents to dispose for free, once a month, bulky items at the TOM site that are often found within illegally dumped loads such as water heaters, swamp coolers, couches, mattresses, etc. Regular household waste and hazardous waste are not accepted at the site.

On March 13, 2007, the Board authorized the Waste Management Department to waive the disposal fees on illegally dumped material retrieved by TLMA in support of the recently revamped Code Enforcement Department. Since the CSD's illegal dumping retrieval efforts, along with the customer convenience of the TOM site, augment existing County efforts and therefore lessen the burden on County resources, the Waste Management Department is requesting authorization to waive the disposal fees on waste accepted at the TOM site during fiscal year 07/08, not to exceed 170 tons. Staff will coordinate annually with the CSD on the estimated funding for each fiscal year and obtain the specific dollar amount approval from the Board via the Department's budget.
