SUBJECT: Approval of Memorandum of Understanding between the State of California Administrative Office of the Courts and the County for Construction of Temporary Courtrooms

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approve and authorize the Chairman to sign the Memorandum of Understanding between the State of California Administrative Office of the Courts and the County for construction of temporary courtrooms at Riverside Family Law and Corona Court facilities.

BACKGROUND: Due to the assignment of twelve judges on a temporary basis to relieve the backlog of the criminal court system in Riverside County, a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) has been prepared to allow construction of temporary courtrooms at the Riverside Family Law and Corona court facilities. The Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) will conduct the construction of said courtrooms, and the county agrees to exercise appropriate oversight to ensure applicable building standards and codes are adhered.
