SUBJECT: Fourth Amendment to the agreement between Blood Bank of San Bernardino/Riverside Counties and RCRMC.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Approve the fourth amendment to the agreement with Blood Bank of San Bernardino/Riverside Counties and RCRMC for the performance period of July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008, pursuant to applicable California Code, without securing competitive bids, in accordance with Ordinance 459.4;
- 2) Authorize the Chairman to execute the amendment;
- 3) Direct the Clerk of the Board to retain one original and return two (2) original copies of the amendment to RCRMC - Contract Administration for further distribution and processing.

BACKGROUND: This amendment continues the agreement approved by the Board on October 7, 2003, item 3.32, with the Blood Bank of San Bernardino and Riverside counties to provide blood product and blood-related services for the Hospital's emergency and surgical patients. No other vendor offers these services in this geographic area, and transporting the blood product from another County would not be cost efficient or practical.
