

SUBJECT: Renewal of the Local Emergency Declaration for Riverside County due to extreme drought conditions.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the declaration relating to drought conditions adopted as Agenda Item 3.75 on July 17, 2007, Resolution Number 2007-351 be renewed.

BACKGROUND: The Riverside County Agricultural Commissioner's Office has reviewed the emergency conditions necessitating the declaration of July 17, 2007, and find that these conditions still exist. Government Code Section 8630 requires the Board to review the need for continuation of the local emergency every 14 days.
