

SUBJECT: Construction of Median Island Hard-scape Using River Rock, Limonite Avenue, Baldwin Avenue to 510 Feet East of Clay Street, Indian Hills area

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approve the plans and specifications for the construction of median island hard-scape using river rock on Limonite Avenue, from Baldwin Avenue to 510 feet east of Clay Street in the Indian Hills area of Riverside County. Authorize the Clerk to advertise for bids to be received in the office of the Director of Transportation up to the hour of 2:00 pm, Wednesday, August 8, 2007, at which time bids will be opened.

BACKGROUND: The Limonite Avenue median within the subject limits was improved with landscaping and hard-scaping under a contract administered by the Economic Development Agency in 2000. The improvements are maintained under Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated, Zone 4. The Transportation Department has been requested by EDA to administer the construction of hard-scape modifications of the median between Baldwin Avenue and 510 feet easterly of Clay Street to replace large areas of decomposed granite with river rock hard-scaping in order to control

Phases 1, 2 & 3

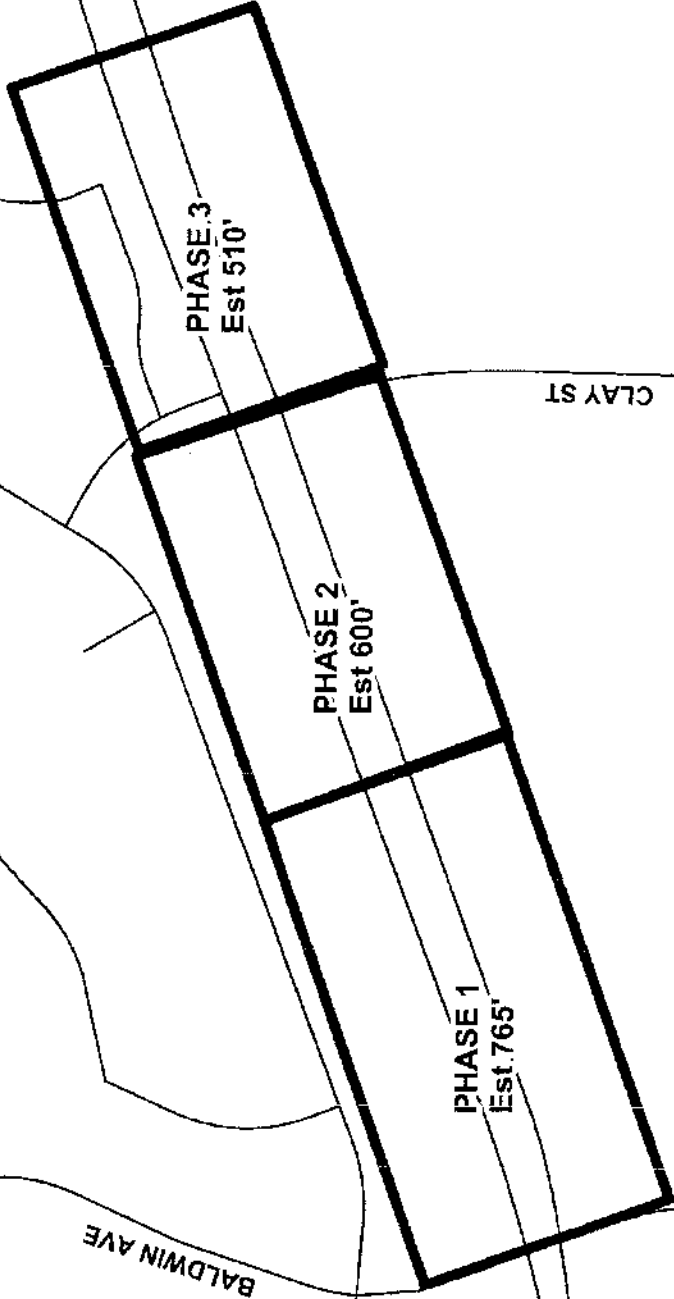
