SUBJECT: JURUPA CHANNEL, STAGE 4 (Project No. 1-0-00230-04) Cooperative Agreement

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board approve the Cooperative Agreement between the County of Riverside (County) and the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) to provide \$900,000 for the construction of storm drain improvements and authorize the Chairman to execute the Agreement documents on behalf of the County.

BACKGROUND: The Jurupa Channel, Stage 4 improvements are part of the Valley Way/Armstrong Road Improvement Project which is located in the unincorporated community of Sunnyslope on Valley Way/Armstrong Road between Mission Boulevard and Sierra Avenue. The proposed improvements for the Valley Way/Armstrong Road Improvement Project include the reconstruction and road widening of Valley Way/Armstrong Road, which will add two additional lanes and a median area to the existing two-lane road. Additionally, the project will complete the curb, gutter and sidewalk in areas were it currently does not exist, will include the construction of storm drain improvements (Jurupa Channel, Stage 4) and will provide modifications to the traffic signals at Sierra Avenue, 34th Street, and the State Route 60 west bound ramps.



RE: JURUPA CHANNEL, STAGE 4 (Project No. 1-0-00230-04) Cooperative Agreement

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The Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions by which the District will contribute funding for the construction of the storm drain improvement portion of the project that is to be constructed by the Transportation Department. Upon completion of construction, the District will accept the mainline storm drain facility for ownership operation and maintenance.

The County will administer the construction contract and grant the District the necessary rights to construct, operate and maintain the project within County road right of way, and will assume responsibility for the operation and maintenance of the project's associated catch basins and laterals located within County road right of way.

County Counsel has approved the Agreement as to legal form. A companion item appears on District's agenda this same date.
