
**SUBJECT:** Hemet Master Drainage Plan Line D, Stage 5

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** Approve the Cooperative Agreement between the County of Riverside and the Riverside County Flood Control District; and authorize the Chairman to execute the Agreement documents on behalf of the Riverside County Transportation Department and amend the Transportation Improvement Program by addition of this project.

**BACKGROUND:** The Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions by which the Hemet Master Drainage Plan Line D, Stage 5 storm drain is to be constructed by the District.

The District is funding all construction and construction inspection costs. Upon completion of project construction, the District will assume ownership, operation and maintenance of the mainline storm drain and major laterals.

The County is granting the District the necessary rights to construct, operate and maintain the project within road right-of-way and, upon completion of project construction, will assume ownership, operation and maintenance of the project's associated minor drain laterals.
