1. Approve the use of Community Improvement Designation Funds for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Gala at the Edward-Dean Museum & Gardens; and
2. Direct the Auditor-Controller to adjust appropriations, estimated revenue and designations as follows:


Increase Estimated Revenue: \$25,000

Decrease Board Designation: \$25,000  
10000-1000100000-320135 Community Improvement

**BACKGROUND:** The Edward-Dean Museum & Gardens is a County museum and cultural resource. The annual gala event raises funds for much-needed rehabilitation and restoration of the grounds and facilities. This use of Community Improvement Designation funds allows staff to pay for the event while the funds that are raised are used for the restoration and rehabilitation.

I request that the Board of Supervisors approve a contribution of \$25,000 to support the ongoing needs at the Edward-Dean Museum & Gardens.
