

SUBJECT: Closure of Hazardous Fire Area within Whitewater Canyon

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approve the addition of Whitewater Canyon to the closure of all Hazardous Fire Areas in the Unincorporated Area of Riverside County until such time as the County Fire Chief permits them to be re-opened.

BACKGROUND: County Ordinance 787 requires the Board of Supervisor's approval for the closure of hazardous fire areas for more than fifteen (15) days. The Whitewater Canyon area is requested to be added to the previously approved closure areas due to the potential for dangerous fires in this area. This closure will accompany a Federal closure of Bureau of Land Management (BLM) lands within the Whitewater Canyon area. These areas will be closed to the public except for the public roadways, inhabited areas, and the Pacific Crest Trail.
