


SUBJECT: Sherman Road Signalization Project and Romoland Beautification Project

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board approve and authorize the Chairman to execute the attached agreement by and between the Redevelopment Agency for the County of Riverside (RDA) and Riverside County Transportation Department (TLMA) for the Sherman Road Signalization and Median Project in Romoland.

BACKGROUND: On August 10, 2004, the RDA entered into an agreement with Albert A. Webb Associates to prepare plans and specifications for the Romoland Beautification Project which includes irrigated landscaping, monument signs at the entryways, and curb, gutter, and sidewalk improvements on Highway 74 from Interstate 215 to Palomar Road; on Trumble Road between Highway 74 and Mapes Road; and landscaping of the I-215/Highway 74 interchange. On July 25, 2006 the First Amendment to that Agreement was approved by the Board for additional design, phasing and construction management services. The Second Amendment will provide for the design of the traffic signals and median at the intersection of Sherman Road and Highway 74 as well as additional survey work required to execute the project. TLMA is providing \$54,250 and the RDA will provide the balance of \$68,250 for the \$122,500 contract amendment. Staff recommends approval of this amendment.


