**BACKGROUND:**

CDC provides funding to counties for a statewide outreach campaign, Seniors Against Investment Fraud (S.A.I.F), designed to inform seniors how to avoid investment scams and fraud schemes. DPSS utilizes these funds to:

- Train volunteers who educate seniors of Riverside County about these fraud scams; and
- Promote the S.A.I.F. program in partnership with appropriate local law enforcement and consumer groups.

If approved, Amendment #1 would increase the mileage reimbursement rate from 34 cents to 48.5 cents, clarify DPSS' reporting duties, and specifically prohibit reimbursement of travel in the performance of this Agreement outside of California without the prior written authorization of the State. Other nonsubstantive changes to the Agreement would also be made.

The Board approved the original S.A.I.F. revenue agreement with the California Department of Corporations on July 11, 2006 (#3.48).

**FINANCIAL IMPACT:**

The entire program is funded by CDC. No County funds are requested.
