SUBJECT: Matching Funds for "Sheltering Wings," a non-profit agency providing services for the developmentally disabled in Blythe

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve Fourth District Community Improvement Designation funds to Sheltering Wings of Blythe for use as 1/3 matching funds for a Rehabilitation Establishment Grant.
2. Approve and direct the Auditor-Controller to make the following budget adjustment:

BACKGROUND: Sheltering Wings provides vital services to developmentally disabled adults in the Palo Verde Valley in the remote east end of the Fourth District. In order to secure a Department of Rehabilitation grant, local participating agencies need to allocate a total of \$7,668, meaning the three participating agencies—the County of Riverside, the City of Blythe and Sheltering Wings—would each have to fund one-third of the local match.
