3 **RESOLUTION NO. 2007-419**

4 **CREATING THE SAN GORGONIO PASS MUNICIPAL ADVISORY COUNCIL**

5  
6 **WHEREAS**, Government Code §31010 and Riverside County Board of Supervisors Policy No. A-51  
7 provides for the creation of a Municipal Advisory Council within the unincorporated territory for the purpose of  
8 advising the Board of Supervisors on matters including, but not limited to, public safety, planning, health,  
9 transportation, parks and community development; and

10 **WHEREAS**, creation of a Municipal Advisory Council has been requested by residents in the San  
11 Gorgonio Pass area of Riverside; now, therefore,

12 **BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED** by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of  
13 California, in regular session assembled on August 28, 2007, that the San Gorgonio Pass Municipal Advisory  
14 Council is hereby created.

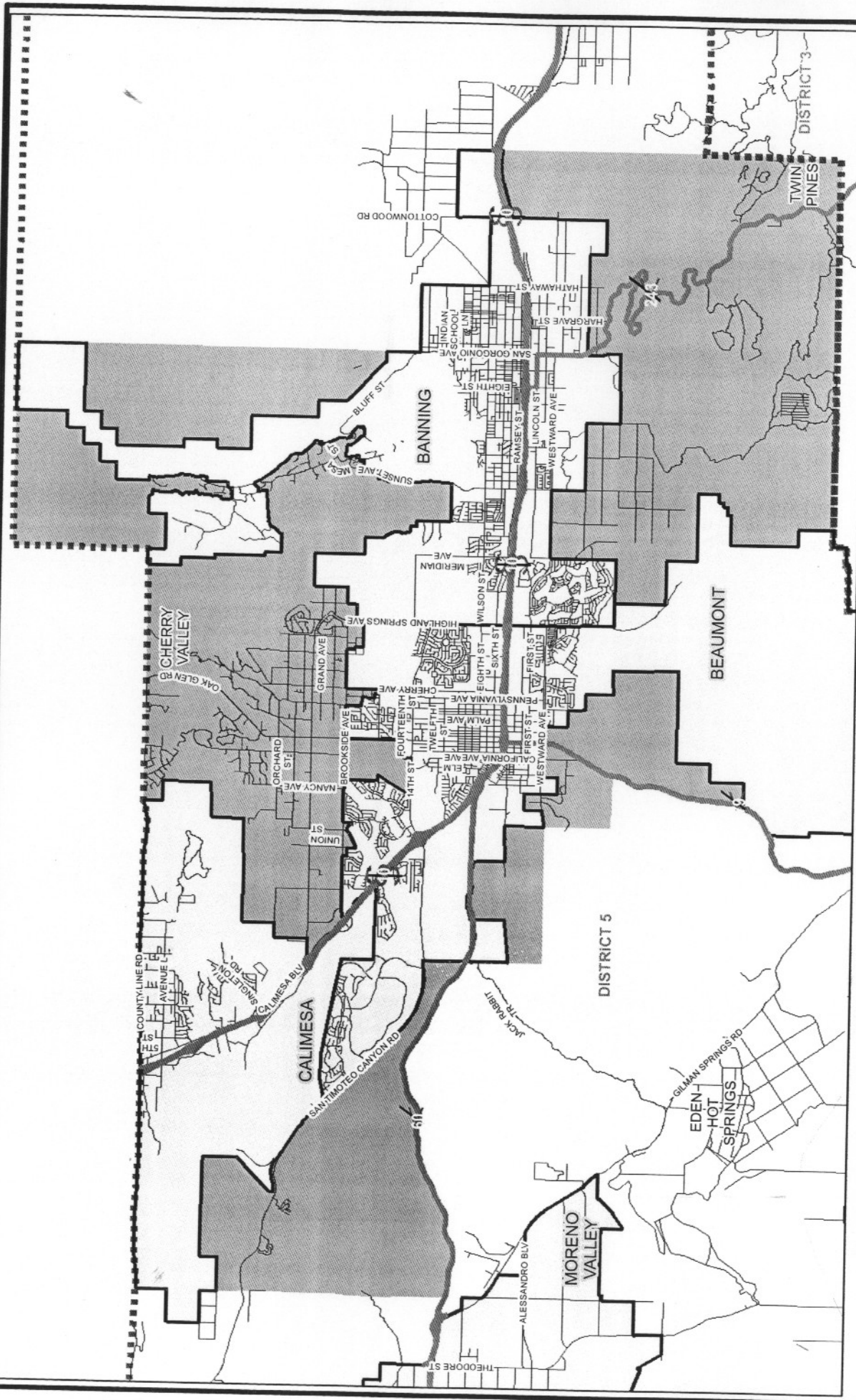
15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED** that the operation of the San Gorgonio Pass Municipal  
16 Advisory Council (hereinafter referred to as the "San Gorgonio Pass MAC") shall be in compliance with the rules,  
17 regulations and procedures prescribed in Riverside County Board of Supervisors Policy No. A-51, and with the  
18 specific provisions delineated below in the Resolution.

- 19 1. **TERRITORY.** The territory for which the San Gorgonio Pass MAC is established, and area over  
20 which it extends, is situated within the Fifth Supervisorial District of Riverside County as more  
21 specifically shown and depicted in Exhibit A & Exhibit B to this Resolution.
- 22 2. **MEMBERSHIP.** San Gorgonio Pass MAC shall consist of five (5) regular members and two (2)  
23 alternate members, each of whom shall be appointed by and serve at large at the pleasure of the  
24 Board of Supervisors. All appointees shall be at least eighteen (18) years of age and be a resident,  
25 landowner or business owner within the San Gorgonio Pass MAC territory.

3. **TERM.** Appointed members shall serve without compensation for a term of two (2) years, except that in order to establish a system of staggered terms, one initial alternate member and two of the regular members initially appointed shall serve until August 30, 2009. The other three regular members and one alternate member initially appointed shall serve until August 30, 2011. Thereafter, all terms shall be for two (2) full years from May 1 of the year appointed to April 30 two (2) years hence.

4. **BOARD POLICY NO. A-51.** The provisions of Riverside County Board of Supervisors Policy No. A-51 on the subject of "Formation/Operation of Municipal Advisory Councils and Community Councils" are affixed hereto as Exhibit C incorporated into this resolution by reference, and are intended for the guidance of the San Geronio Pass MAC in carrying out its duties.
