SUBJECT: Approval of the Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with San Bernardino County for the distribution of Ryan White Comprehensive AIDS Resource Emergency (CARE) Act Title I funds.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Approve the Intergovernmental Agreement with San Bernardino County for the Distribution of Ryan White Care Act Title I Funds; and,
- 2) Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign five (5) copies of the Agreement.

BACKGROUND: On December 19, 2006 the Ryan White HIV/AIDS Treatment Modernization Act (RWHATMA) of 2006 was signed into law. This represented the fourth re-authorization of the Ryan White Comprehensive AIDS Resource Emergency Act (RWCA) of 1990. Funds from RWHATMA provide financial relief to geographic areas significantly impacted by AIDS and HIV. In 1993, the counties of Riverside and San Bernardino together became eligible to receive funds for HIV care, treatment and supportive services.

SUBJECT: Approval of the Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with San Bernardino County for the distribution of Ryan White Comprehensive AIDS Resource Emergency (CARE) Act Title I funds.

BACKGROUND (Continued):

Legislation requires that multi-jurisdictional areas negotiate an intergovernmental agreement (IGA) that:

- 1) Establishes a planning council;
- 2) Designates the size of the planning council;
- 3) Designates chairs or co-chairs; and
- 4) Designates a method to allocate the funds between the jurisdictions.

The first IGA was signed in 1994 and renegotiated in 1998, 2003 and in 2007. Changes in the RWHATMA require some adjustment to the existing IGA:

- The new language changed the status of the two county jurisdictions from an eligible metropolitan area (EMA) to a transitional grant area (TGA). The reauthorized Act created a tier structure for allocation of funds changing our status from an EMA to a TGA.
- The sections of the Act have been changed from Title to Part. Riverside and San Bernardino receive Part A and Part B funds, formerly referred as Title I and Title II.
- The reauthorized Act changed the way that funds for administration and planning council support are allocated and distributed. Section III of the revised IGA reflects the changes in the administration and support structure.
- The reauthorized Act codified the Minority AIDS Initiative (MAI) funds requiring a plan to distribute the funds throughout the two counties. MAI funds are to be used to develop and enhance access to culturally and linguistically appropriate high quality community based HIV care services and to improve health outcomes for minority individuals and families.

The IGA will be effective when the San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors executes the agreement after being approved by the Riverside County Board of Supervisors.

Financial Data: This agreement has no financial impact on the County of Riverside.

This IGA has been approved as to form by County Counsel.
