BACKGROUND:

Each year the CDE allocates state funding to DPSS so that eligible families and/or children, as defined by the CDE who meet the criteria of the California Education Code, can receive subsidized child development services. This funding is utilized by Children Services to provide child care services to families in order to decrease the risk of children re- entering foster care as well as increase the prospects of family reunification. The average monthly cost per child is between \$396 and \$450. In Fiscal Year 2006/07, an average of 352 children were served per month.

Therefore, the Interim Director of DPSS respectfully requests approval of the attached CAPP-7051 Local Agreement to the Fiscal Year 2007/2008 for child care services with CDE.

FINANCIAL IMPACT: No County General Funds are required.
