SUBJECT: 2nd and 5th Districts' Use of Community Improvement Designation Funds for Grant Writer

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Riverside County Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve the use of Community Improvement Designation Funds for the grant writer position within the Economic Development Agency (EDA) to assist non-profit agencies within the 2nd and 5th Supervisorial Districts with fundraising; and
2. Direct the Auditor-Controller to make the following budget adjustments:


Increase Appropriations: \$125,000
10000-1000100000-551100 Contributions to Other County Agency Funds


Decrease Board Designation: \$125,000

BACKGROUND: In Fiscal Year 2006/07, the Board of Supervisors approved the hiring of a grant writer within EDA to work exclusively with non-profit agencies within the 2nd and 5th Supervisorial Districts. EDA hired Pamela Hogan who has been working closely with non-profit agencies to prepare grant applications and to build capacity. In order to continue this successful effort, we are requesting funding for the current fiscal year (07/08) in the amount of \$125,000, to be funded equally with \$62,500 from District 2 and District 5 Community Improvement Designation Funds.
