SUBJECT: Adoption of Resolution #2007-422 Authorizing the Sheriff's Department to Submit a Grant Application to the California Department of Parks and Recreation

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors adopt Resolution #2007-422, which authorizes the Sheriff to sign and submit a grant application to the California Department of Parks and Recreation, Division of Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation for \$548,000 to continue off-highway vehicle (OHV) law enforcement efforts in Riverside County and expand enforcement by targeting sites in the unincorporated areas of all five Supervisorial Districts.

BACKGROUND: The California Department of Parks and Recreation is currently accepting grant applications for its Off-Highway Vehicle Enforcement Program. On September 10, 2002 (3.32), the Board accepted two Project Agreements with the Department for a County off-highway motor vehicle enforcement program. Christened the Riverside Off-Highway Vehicle Enforcement Program (R.O.V.E.), this innovative and effective program has put Deputies on all-terrain vehicles (ATVs) to enforce laws concerning illegal off-highway driving, dumping, driving under the influence and environmental destruction. The use of ATVs versus pursuits off-highway in black and white units also has substantially increased officer safety. The Board accepted and approved project grant agreements to continue this effort for a second year on April 27, 2004 (3.18), and for a third year on July 12, 2005 (3.58).

The current application will begin Phase IV of the Sheriff's county-wide effort by expanding enforcement efforts in all five Supervisorial Districts with a proposed start date of February 2008. The application requests \$548,000 to support Deputy Sheriff overtime, purchase equipment and provide OHV education in continued and expanded patrols in problematic areas.

The grant application includes a 25% County match in the amount of \$137,000. The Department proposes contributing an in-kind match of \$900,947 for the project's regular salaries, and a \$49,090 cash match for materials, supplies and equipment purchases. All local match contributions will come from the Department's status quo budget. Any grant awarded will be submitted to the Board of Supervisors for review and approval.

During the development of this phase of the county-wide project, the Sheriff requested public comment via a posting on the Department's web site and through mailings to interested individuals.

9 WHEREAS, The people of the State of California have enacted the Off-Highway
10 Motor Vehicle Recreation Act of 2003, which provides funds to the State of California and its
11 political subdivisions for, Acquisition Projects, Conservation Projects, Development Projects,
12 Facilities Operation and Maintenance Projects, Law Enforcement Projects OHV Safety and/or
13 Education Program Projects, Planning Projects, Restoration Projects, and Trail Maintenance
14 Projects for off-highway vehicle recreation; and

15 WHEREAS, the Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation Division with the California
16 Department of Parks and Recreation has been delegated the responsibility to administer the
17 program; and

18 WHEREAS, procedures established by the California Department of Parks and
19 Recreation require the Applicant's Governing Body to certify by resolution the approval of the
20 Application to apply for Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Grant; funds; and

21 WHEREAS, this Project appears on, or is in conformance with this jurisdiction's adopted
22 general or master plan and is compatible with the land use plans of those jurisdictions
23 immediately surrounding the Project;

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Riverside County Board of Supervisors
25 hereby:

1. Approves the filing of an Application(s) for an Off-Highway Vehicle Grant or Cooperative Agreement; and

- 1 2. Certifies that Riverside County understands its legal obligations to the State upon approval
2 of the Grant; and
- 3 3. Certifies that Riverside County understands the California Public Resources Code
4 requirement that acquisition and development Projects be maintained to specific
5 conservation standards; and
- 6 4. Certifies that the Project will be well-maintained during its useful life; and
- 7 5. Certifies that Riverside County will implement the Project with diligence once funds are
8 available and the Applicant has reviewed, understands, and agrees with the Project
9 Agreement; and
- 10 6. Certifies that the County will provide the required Matching Funds (as applicable) in the
11 event that it accepts the award; and
- 12 7. Certifies that the public and adjacent property owners have been notified of this Project (as
13 applicable); and
- 14 8. Appoints the Sheriff as agent to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents
15 including, but not limited to Applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests and
16 so on, which may be necessary for completion of the Project.
