RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Approve the Cooperative Agreement between the District and the City of Corona; and authorize the Chairman to execute the Agreement documents on behalf of the District.

BACKGROUND:

The Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions by which the subject storm drains are to be constructed by the District.

The District is funding all storm drain construction and construction inspection costs. The City is to provide funding for certain waterline relocation and street improvement costs. Upon completion of project construction, the District will assume ownership, operation and maintenance of the mainline storm drain.
