SUBJECT: APPROVAL TO DONATE SURPLUS MOBILE DATA TERMINALS TO THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

Authorize the Director of Purchasing and Fleet Services to donate surplus mobile data terminals to the County of Los Angeles Sheriff's Department.

BACKGROUND: The County of Riverside has utilized Electrocom Automation's MDT 870 mobile data terminals (MDT) in the Sheriff's patrol vehicles for several years. Over the last few years the County has been replacing these with newer technology terminals as vehicles came out of service or the terminals broke down. The County has actually gone through two new generations of MDT's since these were put in place and has no use for these older technology units.

BACKGROUND (Continued)

The Los Angeles Sheriff's Department is in the process of developing a new communications system with an anticipated completion date in 2013. Until that time, they will continue to utilize many of these old MDT's in their fleet and have requested our surplus units to utilize for repair parts. As these MDT's have little or no value on the surplus market, Purchasing requests authorization to donate these to Los Angeles County. There are 36 units available now and approximately 80 additional units that may become available.
