SUBJECT: Ratify the Second Amendment to the Agreement between ACS Healthcare Solutions and RCRMC

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors

- 1) Ratify the second amendment to the agreement between ACS Healthcare Solutions for the period of July 1, 2007 through December 31, 2007.
- 2) Authorize the Purchasing Agent to sign the amendment on behalf of the County, not to exceed an additional \$46,800.00

BACKGROUND: In September 2004, RCRMC embarked on a strategic planning project to determine the best direction for both clinical and financial systems for RCRMC.

Through a competitive bid process a contract was awarded to the low bidder, ACS Healthcare Solutions to provide the consulting service necessary to study the hospital's information systems and to assist RCRMC in developing an information systems strategic plan for the medical center. This strategic plan was presented to the Board on January 24, 2006.

**SUBJECT: Ratify the Second Amendment to the Agreement between ACS
Healthcare Solutions and RCRMC**

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BACKGROUND (Continued):

On June 13, 2006, agenda item number 3.27, the Board authorized the Purchasing Agent to amend the consultant's agreement and to add services to assist in the selection of a new Core Healthcare system. These services included the development of a detailed RFP and evaluation criteria.

This second amendment is to expand the scope of the agreement for contract negotiations with the top two vendors identified to include preparation of vendor pros and cons for Execute Management, an estimate of total cost of ownership, and the review of implementation activities for each vendor to facilitate a decision regarding the preferred vendor.

PRICE REASONABLENESS

The contractor certifies that the underlying rates used as basis for the fixed fees offered in the original Strategic Plan agreement RFP #PUARC460 are the same as the underlying rates used as basis for the fixed fees to add the Healthcare Information Systems Selection process to the agreement.
