BACKGROUND:

On June 1, 2 and 3, 2007, the Temecula Valley Balloon & Wine Association held its annual event at Lake Skinner Recreation Area in Winchester, California. The event generated \$56,714 in revenue to the Park District from gate admissions, parking, and camping. There was excellent cooperation among the community, the Festival Association, Riverside County Fire Department, Riverside County Sheriff's Department, Immigration and Naturalization Service, City of Temecula, The Metropolitan Water District, California Highway Patrol and the Regional Park & Open-Space District.
