BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to Subtitle B of the Stewart B. McKinney Homeless Act of 1987 (Public Law 100-77), the City of Riverside has been awarded Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG) funds for the operation and maintenance of emergency shelter facilities. In accordance with program requirements, the City of Riverside would provide to DPSS funding in the amount of \$70,910 for the period of July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008 to defray part of the expenses of the emergency cold weather shelter operated by Path of Life Ministries.

The Board has previously approved similar City of Riverside ESG agreements, most recently on January 23, 2007 (#3.36).

FINANCIAL DATA:

Funds for operating the shelters have been included in the fiscal year 2007-08 budget.
