RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve the use of Community Improvement Designation Funds for parking lot improvements
2. Direct the Auditor-Controller to adjust appropriations, estimated revenue and designations as follows:

Increase Appropriations:

20000-3130100000-528450 Inventory Road Supplies \$23,000

Increase Estimated Revenue:

20000-3130100000-790600 Contributions from other County Funds \$23,000

Increase Appropriations:

10000-1000100000-551100 Contribution to other County Funds \$23,000


Decrease Board Designation:

10000-1000100000-320135 Community Improvement \$23,000
