- (3) If the owner or whoever has possession or control of the real property does not take the above described action within ninety (90) days of the date of the Board's Order to Abate, that representatives of the Code Enforcement Department, Sheriff's Department, and/or a contractor, upon consent of the owner or receipt of a Court Order authorizing entry onto the real property, when necessary under applicable law, shall abate the accumulated rubbish by removing and disposing of the same from the real property.
- (4) The reasonable cost of abatement, after notice and an opportunity for hearing, shall be imposed as a lien on the real property, which may be collected as a special assessment against the real property pursuant to Government Code Section 25845 and Riverside County Ordinance No. 725.
- (5) County Counsel be directed to prepare the necessary Findings of Facts and Conclusions that the accumulated rubbish on the real property is declared to be in violation of Riverside County Ordinance No. 541, and a public nuisance, and further, to prepare an Order to Abate for approval by the Board.

JUSTIFICATION:

1. An initial inspection was made of the subject real property by the Code Enforcement Officer on May 4, 2006. The inspection revealed the accumulated rubbish on the subject property in violation of Riverside County Ordinance No. 541. The rubbish consisted of, but was not limited to: metal, wood, tires, household trash, broken furniture, vegetative waste, pieces of plastic, broken toys, cement pieces, used construction materials, and other trash and debris. The amount of accumulated rubbish was spread throughout the property and measured approximately eight thousand and two hundred (8,200) square feet.
2. Subsequent inspections of the above-described real property on May 16, 2007, July 13, 2007, and September 10, 2007, revealed the property continues to be in violation of Riverside County Ordinance No. 541.
3. Staff and the Code Enforcement Department have complied with the requirements set forth in the appropriate laws of this jurisdiction pertaining to the administrative abatement proceedings for the removal of accumulated rubbish.
