SUBJECT: Professional Medical Services Agreement between the County of Riverside and Wilshire Oncology Medical Group, Inc.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Approve the Professional Medical Services Agreement, effective December 1, 2007, and;
- 2) Authorize the Chairperson to sign three (3) copies of the Agreement; and
- 3) Retain one (1) copy and return two (2) copies of the executed Agreement to Riverside County Regional Medical Center (RCRMC) for distribution.

BACKGROUND: The volume and complexity of the caseload for hematology and oncology professional services and the broad array of teaching programs at RCRMC requires a fully integrated delivery system be implemented for the Hospital. Wilshire Oncology Medical Group offers a cancer care team of trained and dedicated cancer specialists providing innovative and comprehensive cancer care for the Hospital's patients along with technology to enhance the quality, safety and timeliness of the patient's care. All patients will be provided with educational information available for each stage of their disease, performance status and treatment plan.

**SUBJECT: Professional Services Agreement
Wilshire Oncology Medical Group, Inc.**

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BACKGROUND (Continued):

The Professional Medical Services Agreement will provide the services of one (1) physician and one (1) allied health professional to provide oncology/hematology clinical services, inpatient consultations, teaching and supervisory duties. An additional physician will be provide administrative and oversight duties for oncology/hematology services.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT:

Wilshire Oncology Medical Group physicians will provide Hematology and Oncology Professional services as required on an inpatient and outpatient basis to meet the requirements of the Hospital. The Agreement provides the services of one (1) physician and one (1) allied health professional dedicated specifically to the inpatient consultative, outpatient clinical and chemotherapy infusion services for RCRMC. Effective December 1, 2008, an additional allied health professional will be added to provide oncology/hematology services. Maximum annual compensation payable under this Agreement is outlined below.

- a. December 1, 2007 through November 30, 2008
Five hundred thousand (\$500,000) dollars
- b. December 1, 2008 through November 30, 2009
Five hundred fifty thousand (\$550,000) dollars
- c. December 1, 2009 through November 30, 2010
Five hundred seventy-five thousand (\$575,000) dollars
- d. December 1, 2010 through November 30, 2010
Six hundred thousand (\$600,000) dollars

Consistent with other professional services agreements, professional services, as payable by non-county payors would be billable by the medical group. The Counties financial per annum commitment would be limited as outlined above.

There are financial penalties associated with lack of performance in the Hematology and Oncology clinics.

This Agreement has been approved as to form by Riverside County Counsel.
