RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Approve Amendment No. 2 to the agreement which extends the duration of the original agreement from January 1, 2006 to January 1, 2009. It is anticipated that the study contemplated by the original agreement will be completed by January 1, 2009.

BACKGROUND:

The agreement is necessary to assist the SARWQCB as part of its Basin Plan triennial review in evaluating the appropriateness of surface water quality objectives to protect beneficial uses of the Santa Ana River and its tributaries. The District recommends approving the agreement because Riverside County, the District and 12 cities in western Riverside County are required to manage urban runoff from their storm drain systems to comply with stormwater permit conditions based on Basin Plan objectives.
