SUBJECT: Ratify the Fifth Amendment to Agreement HSA0729243 with Quest Diagnostics, Inc.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Authorize the chairman of the Board of Supervisors to ratify the Fifth Amendment to the Agreement between Quest Diagnostics Inc. and Riverside County Community Health Agency for the amount of \$1,400,000.00 for a period of performance from July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008; and
2. Authorize the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors to sign (4) copies of the said Amendment on behalf of the County.

BACKGROUND: On December 23, 2002, item 3.22, the Board of Supervisors approved the Agreement between County of Riverside Community Health Agency and Quest Diagnostics, Inc. This award was based on a Request for Proposal (RFP) and Community Health Agency (CHA) Contract # DPH03K-033 that provides laboratory services to the Department of Public Health.

BACKGROUND: (continued)

Because of high volume, Community Health Agency routinely uses laboratory services not performed by the County's in-house testing laboratories. Additionally CHA includes high volume panels requested by Community Health Agency Clinics. Contract pricing on these high volume procedures is very competitive and warrants referral to outside facilities.
