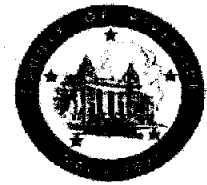

BACKGROUND: (Continued).

California Department of Public Health (DPH) Vector-Borne Disease Section (VBDS) is awarding funds to Riverside County Department of Public Health for emergency West Nile Virus surveillance in the amount of \$30,414 which must be used by December 31, 2007.

These funds will be expended for emergency West Nile Virus (WNV) public education, medical community outreach and /or human case surveillance for the purpose of reducing the risk of West Nile virus transmission to residents with Riverside County.

Disease Control and Riverside County Vector Control will conduct outreach activities targeting areas frequented by seniors (e.g. Senior Centers, mass influenza vaccination clinics and skilled nursing homes). Educational spots will be run during October 2007 targeting select communities in Riverside County. Messages will include preventive measures and resources for information on WNV. The Public Health laboratory will use EIA kits to test human specimens for WNV.

This amendment has been approved as to form by County Counsel.
