

**SUBJECT: 2007 California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection Volunteer Fire Assistance Grant Agreement.**

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors

1. Accept \$9,858 in grant funding awarded to Riverside County Fire Department (RCOFD) by the 2007 California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection Volunteer Fire Assistance (VFA) Grant Program.
2. Authorize the Fire Chief to administer all actions necessary and to sign any related grant documents to implement the grant: and
3. Authorize the Auditor- Controller to make budget adjustments shown on Schedule A.

**BACKGROUND:** As a result of fire service regulations related to personal protective equipment (PPE), RCOFD must purchase new fire shelters. The VFA grant provides funding for rural areas to purchase this type of PPE. RCOFD was awarded \$9,858 in funding to purchase 62 new shelters that will be stored and distributed by the following rural fire stations: Nuview #3, Quail Valley #5, Highgrove #19, Cherry Valley #22, Pine Cove #23, Anza #29, Winchester #34, Homeland #54; and Lake Riverside #77. The grant has a 50/50 cost share requirement as follows: 50% federal (\$9,858) and 50% non-federal (\$9,858) for a total budget of \$19,716. RCOFD's portion of the cost share is in the current year budget.


