WHEREAS, her department has a reputation for consistent high performance in financial and program audits, and

WHEREAS, she has led the development of best practice programs for advisory council, working family caregivers, older workers, and grandparents raising grandchildren, and developed a model care coordination program for at risk seniors, and

WHEREAS, Lu Verne Molberg holds a lifetime teaching credential in public administration and has been associate faculty at the College of St. Thomas, Mankato State University in Minnesota, California State University San Bernardino and the College of the Desert in California.
