SUBJECT: Ratify the Fourth Amendment to Agreement DPH03K.021 with Pro-Tem Personnel, Inc.

BACKGROUND: On October 22, 2002, the Riverside County Board of Supervisors authorized a contract between the Community Health Agency (CHA) and Pro-Tem Personnel, Inc., for temporary services of registered nurses, licensed vocational nurses, nurse practitioners, and other medical office support personnel. The operation of the County Family Care Centers is dependent on reliable staffing. With the success of the Medical Assignment Program (MAP), reliance on registry has significantly diminished. This contract is still needed when mission critical personnel are unavailable through MAP. The annual amount of the contract will be \$50,000, a decrease of \$190,000, because of the Community Health Agency's ability to use the MAP employees.
