BACKGROUND:

City of Rancho Mirage's domestic and wild animals, promote the humane treatment of animals, and enforce the City's Ordinances and State laws relating to animal control. Additionally, the County will be been transporting the animals picked up within Rancho Mirage city limits to the County shelter located in Thousand Palms for housing, redemption and adoption. Existing Animal Services staff will be able to absorb these additional duties; therefore, no additional staffing is needed.

The term of this agreement is through June 30, 2010, with an annual amount of \$10,037 for a total amount of \$30,111. The funding of \$10,037 has been included in the Fiscal Year 07/08 budget; therefore, no budget adjustment is needed.
