**BACKGROUND:** In December 2000 the California State Legislature passed SB2132 that allowed for an emergency appropriation of funds for emergency medical services. There is a well documented crisis in emergency medicine in California due to a lack of funding for uninsured patients. These monies are designated for physicians and hospitals providing uncompensated emergency medical services.
