**SUBJECT:** Acceptance of the FY 2007-08 Automobile Insurance Fraud Grant Program Award and Adoption of Resolution 2007-548

- RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:
1. Approve acceptance of the Automobile Insurance Fraud Grant ("AIF Grant") award from the Insurance Commissioner of the State of California Department of Insurance in the amount of \$383,114 for the grant period July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008.
  2. Adopt Resolution No. 2007-548 authorizing the District Attorney to submit an AIF grant application to the California Department of Insurance and sign grant agreements on behalf of the Board through FY 2009-10. If funding of the grant significantly changes, is altered or discontinued, the department will return to the Board.

**BACKGROUND:**  
The Insurance Commissioner of the State of California has renewed the Automobile Insurance Fraud grant for the July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008 grant period. The grant, awarded under the provision of section 1872.8 of the California Insurance Code, is to be used by the District Attorney solely for the purpose of enhanced investigation and prosecution of automobile insurance fraud cases. The grant award is included in the department's current fiscal year budget.

The attached grant award and resolution have been reviewed and approved as to form by County Counsel.

4 RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE  
5 COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, REGARDING  
6 THE AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE FRAUD PROGRAM

8 WHEREAS, the County of Riverside desires to undertake a certain program designated  
9 Automobile Insurance Fraud Program to be funded in part from funds made available through  
10 Automobile - California Insurance Code Section 1872.8, California Code of Regulations, Title 10, Section  
11 2698.60 and administered by the California Department of Insurance (hereinafter referred to as "DOI");  
12 now, therefore,

13 BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside,  
14 State of California, in regular session assembled on December 18, 2007, that the Board of  
15 Supervisors of the County of Riverside does hereby authorize the District Attorney of the County of  
16 Riverside, State of California to submit and to sign Riverside County's applications for grant funding as  
17 well as related contracts, amendments or extensions with DOI.

18 IT IS AGREED that any liability arising out of the performance of this grant award agreement,  
19 including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the  
20 authorizing agency. The State of California and DOI disclaim responsibility for any such liability.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the resolution shall be in effect for a three-year period  
22 beginning July 1, 2007 and ending June 30, 2010.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant  
24 expenditures controlled by this body.

25 IT IS ALSO AGREED that this award is not subject to hiring freezes.
