

BACKGROUND: (Continued)

have identified 60 site locations that are of interest. Facilities Management is requesting approval to begin the acquisition of candidates for each site via lease, license, MOU or other means. At least 21 of these locations are to be negotiated with private property owners and may end up being purchases rather than leases.

Ten sites are proposed as relocations of existing RCIT communication sites away from towers operated by third parties and may also end up as leases or purchases. Two sites are proposed modifications of existing United States Forest Service (USFS) leaseholds to enlarge our entitlement. 17 new sites are proposed to be built on land under control of various other federal and public agencies and ten sites are proposed to be built on existing County owned land. The sites are categorized and identified by name on the attached Exhibit A.

The department will return to the Board for approval of lease and/or purchase agreements for the sites listed in Exhibit A. This request for in-principle has been reviewed and approved by County Counsel as to legal form.

FINANCIAL DATA:

Funding for PSEC site development was approved under Minute Order 3.42b, dated January 31, 2007, in the amount of \$8.6 million. Purchases and/or lease agreements related to PSEC site acquisition will use this source for funding.
