SUBJECT: Recommendation for Distribution of Excess Proceeds for Tax Sale No. 170, Item 582.
Last assessed to: Security Title Insurance Company, a California Corporation.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Deny the claim from Global Discoveries, Ltd., assignee for Wayne Fong, Vice President for Fidelity Financial for payment of excess proceeds resulting from the Tax Collector's public auction sale associated with parcel 517141008-1;
- 2) Deny the claim, unless pursuant to the California Revenue and Taxation Code Section 4675, an appeal has been filed in Superior Court.

BACKGROUND: In accordance with Section 3691 et seq. of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, and with prior approval of the Board of Supervisors, the Tax Collector conducted the March 16, 2004 public auction sale. The deed conveying title to the purchasers at the auction was recorded May 20, 2004. Further, as required by Section 4676 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, notice of the right to claim excess proceeds was given on June 9, 2004, to parties of interest as defined in Section 4675 of said code. Parties of interest have been determined by an examination of lot book reports as well as Assessor's and Recorder's records, and various research methods were used to obtain current mailing addresses for these parties of interest.

- 1) Claim from Global Discoveries, Ltd., assignee for Wayne Fong, Vice President for Fidelity Financial based on an Assignment of Right to Collect Excess Proceeds dated August 31, 2004 and based on a Grant Deed recorded February 15, 1960 as Instrument No. 13610.

Pursuant to Section 4675 (a) & (b) of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, it is the recommendation of this office that the claim from Global Discoveries, Ltd., assignee for Wayne Fong, Vice President for Fidelity Financial is denied since they have not substantiated their claim.
