3. Authorize the Purchasing Agent to sign ministerial amendments with Shelter From The Storm, not to exceed the maximum amount of the Grant Agreement (\$249,961); and
4. Authorize the Director of DPSS to administer the agreement with Shelter From The Storm.

**SUBJECT: HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT GRANT AGREEMENT—  
SHELTER FROM THE STORM**

**BACKGROUND:**

On May 16, 2006 (Agenda Item 3.18), the Board authorized DPSS to submit an application for Homeless Assistance funds to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, which included the Florence Ridgon House renewal project operated through a contract between Shelter From The Storm (SFTS) and DPSS to provide transitional housing and supportive services to women and children, and youth under 18 years old who are victims of domestic violence.

Shelter From The Storm has served twenty (20) families during the previous one-year grant which expired on July 31, 2007. Under the attached renewal grant, SFTS' goal is to serve thirteen (13) families.

There was a delay with HUD executing the attached renewal Grant Agreement due to modifications to the original application submitted. Due to HUD's late execution, this Agreement is being presented to the Board for approval retroactively to August 1, 2007.
