SUBJECT: Acceptance of the FY 2007-08 Grant Award from the Governor's Office of Emergency Services to Support the Marijuana Suppression Program (MSP)

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors accept a Grant Award from the Governor's Office of Emergency Services in the amount of \$177,168 to support the operations of the MSP.

BACKGROUND: On October 19, 1999 (3.35) the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution 99-389, ratifying a grant award of \$173,251 from the Office of Criminal Justice Planning to defray the cost of a program in the County to suppress the cultivation of marijuana. Each year since that first grant, the County has received funding to help support an eleven-member investigative team, developed within the Sheriff's Special Investigations Bureau and based in East County.
