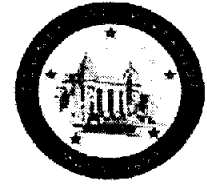

BACKGROUND: (Continued)

Riverside County Department of Public Health, Disease Control STD Program has been awarded a grant for Strategic Planning for Adolescent Health: Local Health Department Collaborations to Prevent HIV, STD and Unintended Pregnancy Demonstration Site through the National Association of County and City Health Official (NACCHO).

The Title of this program is the STD Community Collaborative Enhancement Program (SCCEP). The goal of the SCCEP is through the use of effective partnerships with youth serving agencies to increase the number of youth who understand and implement the Riverside County STD Prevention message. Objective one is to have at least 20,000 Riverside County sexually active youth able to identify the Riverside County's STD Prevention Message. Objective two is to increase by at least 10% the number of sexually active youth who received STD screening. To reach this goal a Health Education Assistant will be hired, through the Temporary Assistance Pool (TAP), to assist and support the existing Health Educator.
