SUBJECT: Exclusive Care - EPO Second Amendment to Behavioral Health Contractor Agreement with Richard I. Torban, M.D., APC dba Desert Psychiatric Associates

RECOMMENDED MOTION: 1) Approve the attached Second Amendment to the Agreement with Richard I. Torban, M.D., doing business as Desert Psychiatric Associates, a multi-disciplinary group of Mental Health Specialists, located in Palm Desert, CA.; 2) authorize the Chairperson to sign four (4) copies of the attached Agreement and; 3) retain one (1) copy of the signed Agreement and return three (3) copies to Human Resources for distribution.

BACKGROUND: In 1999, the Board of Supervisors established the County's self-funded Exclusive Provider Option (EPO) health plan, Exclusive Care, to provide a value health plan option to the employees of Riverside County and their families. To provide services to its enrolled members, Exclusive Care has contracted with a variety of healthcare providers. This Amendment allows Desert Psychiatric Associates to add physicians, psychologists and marriage family therapists with a fee schedule similar to other comparable providers.
